"What!" cried Jack's mother. "Oh, silly boy! How could you give away our milking cow for some measly beans." She threw the beans as far as she could.




In the morning, the beans had sprung up into a big beanstalk. Jack climbed and climbed until he reached the sky.




Jack saw a castle. He ran up the road toward the castle and went inside.
