- Bag rivets (also called angel wings)

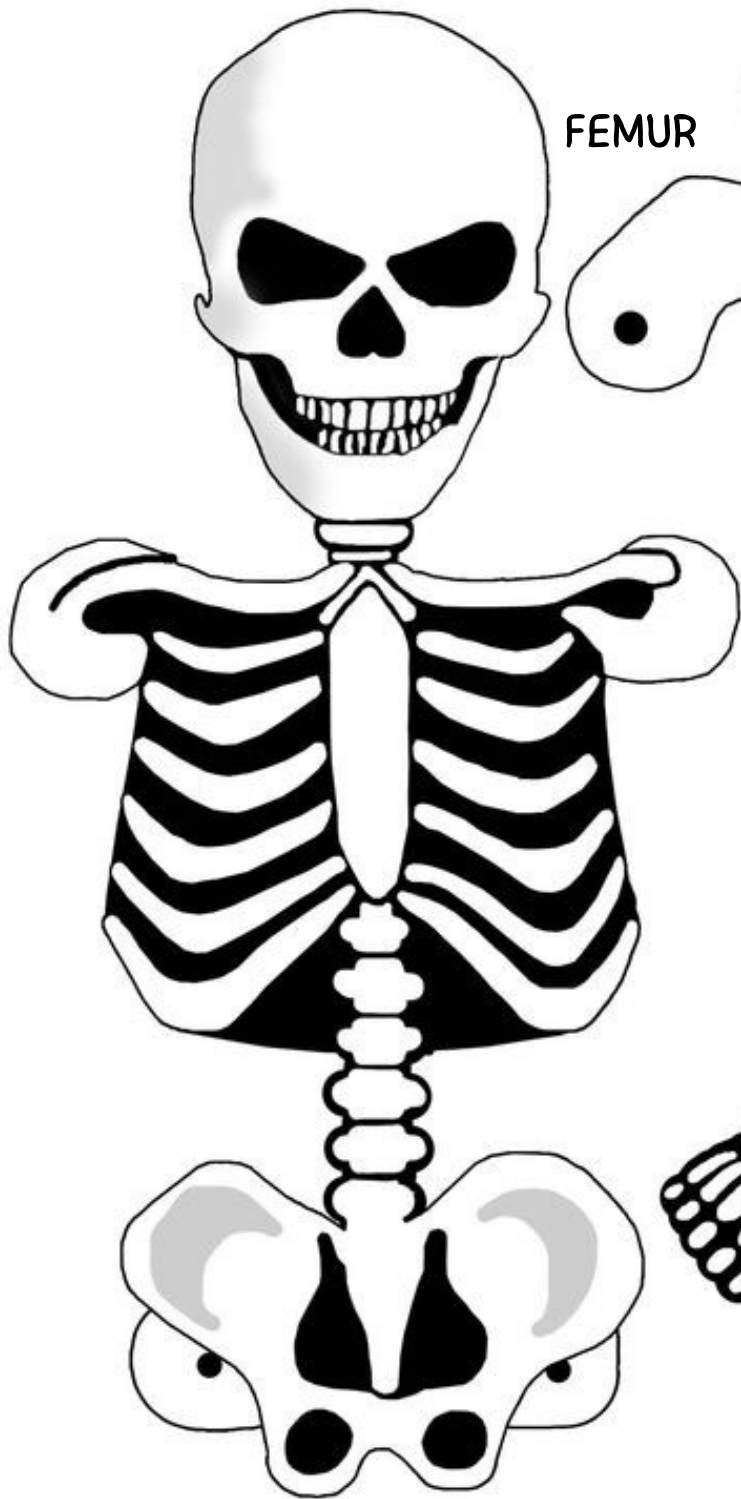
Download and print the page below with the jumping jack.

Glue the print on thicker paper.

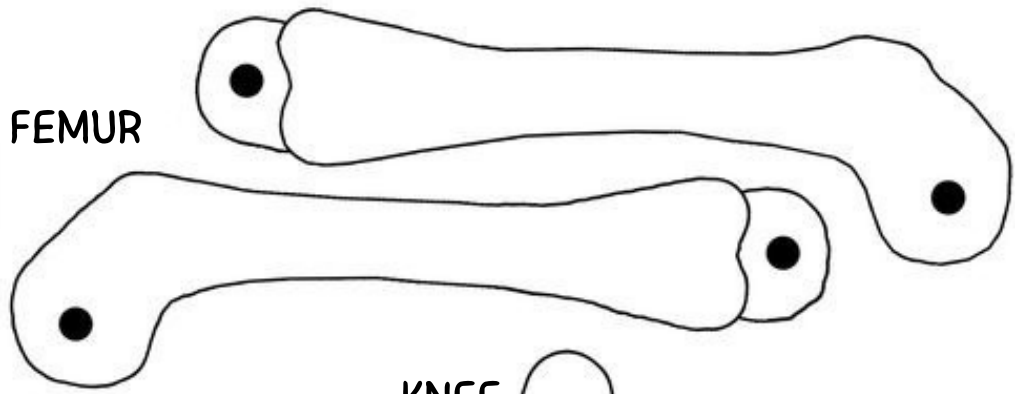
Cut out all the parts and make holes where there is a black dot on the skeleton parts.

Hang on the wall with a string or glue.



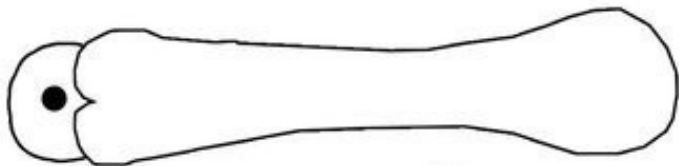
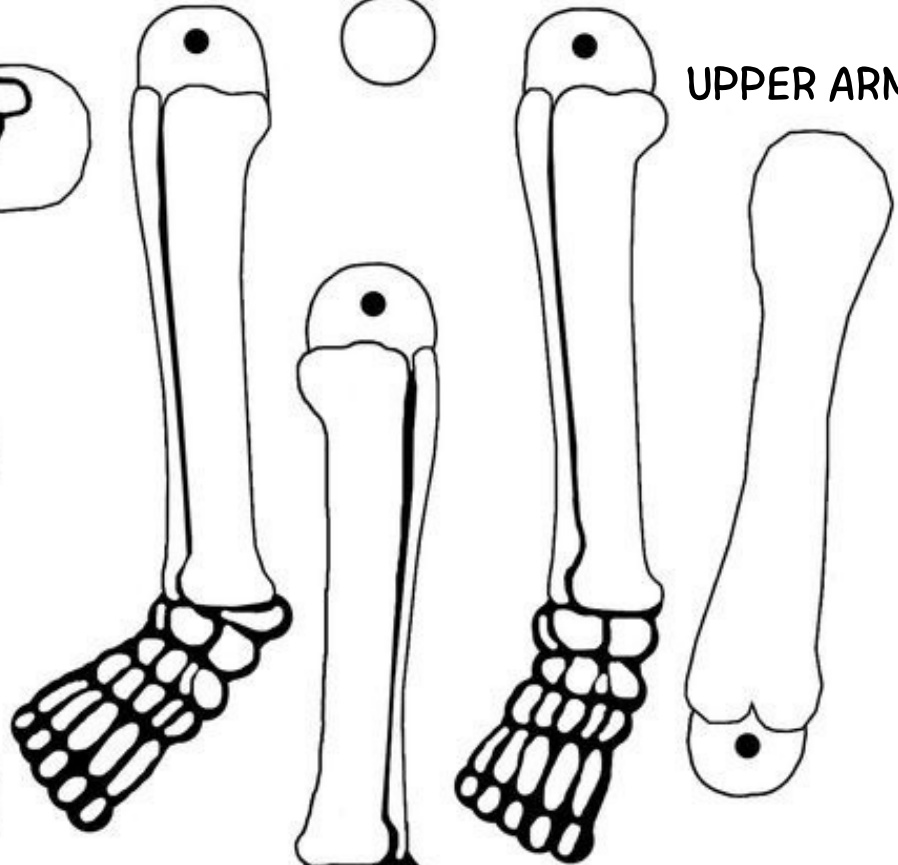
